Hearth Tax

The Hearth Tax was levied twice a year, at Lady Day and Michaelmas, between 1662 and 1688. During these years the tax was the government's major source of revenue. Each hearth was taxed at the rate of two shillings a year, payable by the occupier in two instalments.

Householders who were too poor to be rated to church or poor rates, or who had only a small property, were exempt from paying Hearth Tax. The exemptions included some landless tradespeople, who ran apparently successful businesses.

<u>Notes to accompany 1663 Hearth Tax return for Warmington and Arlescote</u> The lord of the manor, Symon Davis (2 hearths) shared the 7-hearth Manor House with his widowed mother, Mary Davis (1 hearth) and his daughter's husband Thomas Knight (4 hearths). Similarly, Richard Borrowes, senior and junior, shared their house in Arlescote. Other Arlescote residents, listed consecutively on the 1663 return, were William Goodwin, Thomas Enock, Peter Davis and Thomas Hopcroft.
